## Guiding Principles in Schedule Development

- Design a schedule that does not diminish or eliminate middle school courses or programming
- Create consistent schedules for in school, hybrid, \& distance learning
- Align hybrid models to Extent Possible with Elementary \& High School
- Responsive to ongoing Feedback and Input from Stakeholders
- Build in time to support professional responsibilities and development


## Middle School Hybrid Schedule for Students

- Schedule: M-Th 8:30-2:45 and F 8:30-12:30
- Distance Learning Block: M-Th 3:00-3:30
- A-K Group: M-W-F week 1 and T-Th week 2
- L-Z Group: T-Th week 1 and M-W-F week 2

Follows same pattern for week 3 and week 4 of the month.

## Defining Cohorting/Grouping at the Middle School

- Cohorting: Ensure that student and staff groupings are as static as possible by having the same group of children stay with the same staff (all day for young children, and as much as possible for older children). Cohorting is NOT possible in the MS Hybrid Model.
- Teaming Model: Students assigned to Teams (70-95). Teams will be divided in half by alphabet. This is a mitigating measure to reduce the number of students in the school on a given day and to adhere to social distancing guidelines to the greatest extent possible.
- Hybrid Groups by Alphabetical: (Groups A-K and L-Z) on alternate days. Students remain at least 6 feet apart as much as possible and do not share objects.
- Class Sizes: 12-14 students on average (Max 16)
